Academics

Curriculum & Class

At the end of the sixth year, students are prepared for various external certificate examinations e.g. WAEC, NECO, JAMB, I.G.C.S.E, O-Level GCE (Cambridge), SAT & DELF (French). Sixth year students may also earn business and accounting college credit through ACO's accredited partnership with Silver Learning (ACCA) program.

Grading & Ranking

Grades are computed using an A through F system. Beginning with Senior Secondary School (SSS 1). All subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the weighted GPA computation. Grades are accumulated over 3 terms. ACO does not rank students. Students are required to complete 150 hours of community service for graduation.

Honor Roll Criteria

Honor awards are awarded at the end of each term based on the average % grades of classes.
ACO Scholar = All A's
Highest Honor Roll = up to 7 A's 2 B's out of 9 possible A's
ACO Achiever = 5 A's 4 B's out of 9 possible A's

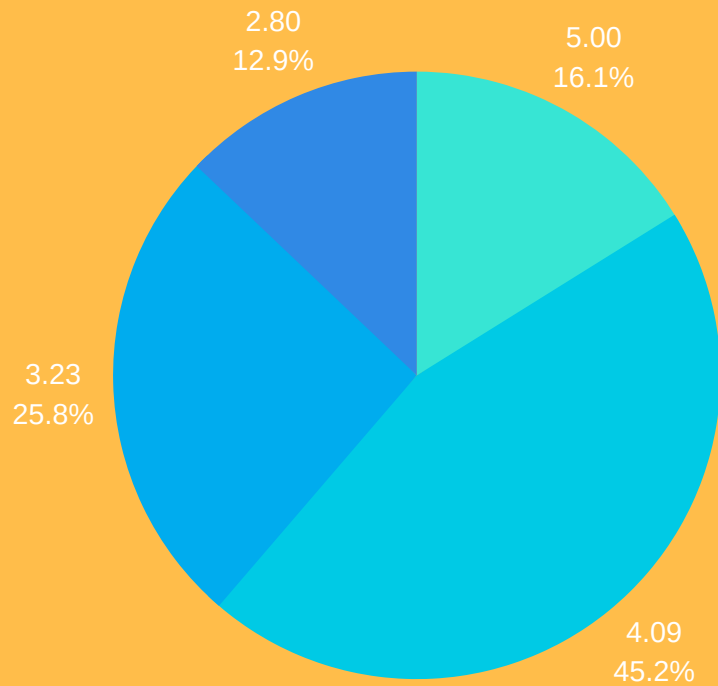
